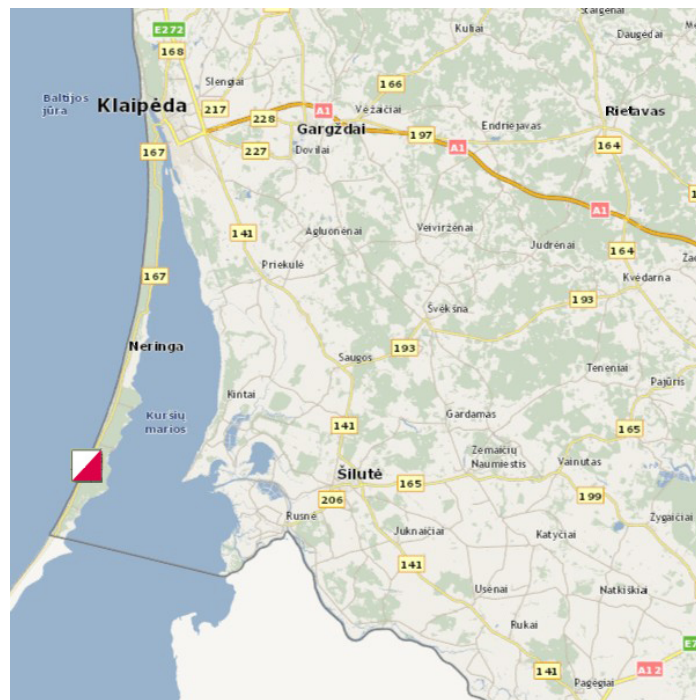

The SportIdent electronic punching system will be used.

PRIZE GIVING

Baltic championships long distance – medals and diplomas for 1 - 3 places, prizes to the winners of each class.

Baltic championships relay – medals and diplomas for 1 - 3 places of each class.

The team winner in overall will be awarded with Cup.

TERRAIN

Long distance and relay will be held in good and fast runnable pine-tree forest with small and middle dune forms.

Some areas are grown up with thick mountain pine-trees and are almost impassable. Less distinct small paths in such areas are hardly runnable.

The difference between highest and lowest points of the terrain is about 35 m.

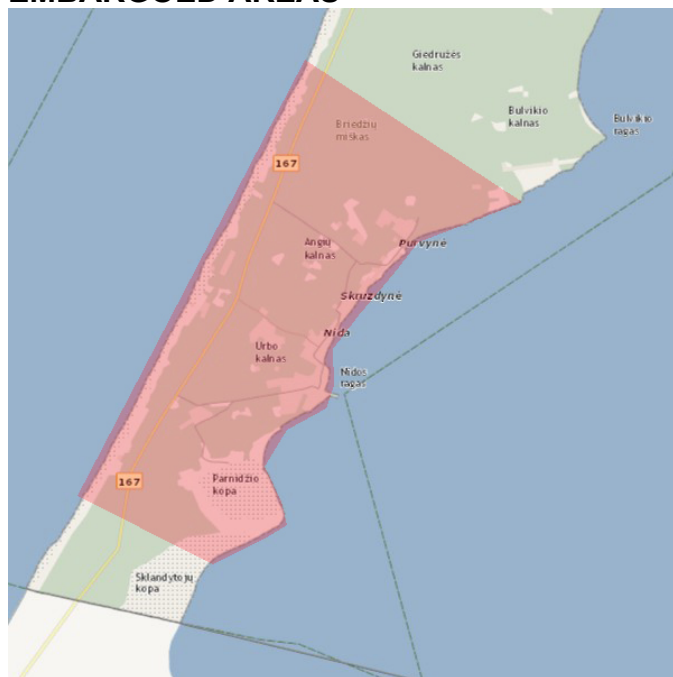
